Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (NTRO8705) affecting the A1067 Drayton High Road from 125m northwest of its junction with Drayton Wood Road to its junction with Yelverton Close ("Road A") and Drayton Wood Road from its junction with A1067 Drayton High Road for 40m north-eastwards ("Road B") in the Parish of Hellesdon to facilitate resurfacing works, the Roads A and B will be temporarily closed/restricted (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 11<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> November 2024, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 28<sup>th</sup> December 2024 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via:

Road A: A1067 (Drayton High Road, Fakenham Road), A1270 Broadland Northway, A140 (Cromer Road, Holt Road, Boundary Road), A1067 Drayton High Road.

Road B: North - Drayton Wood Road, Westwood Drive, Reepham Road, Hall Lane, A1067 Drayton High Road. South - Drayton Wood Road/Westwood Drive, Reepham Road, A140 (Cromer Road, Boundary Road) A1067 Drayton High Road Road.

(Hellesdon, Horsford, Drayton, Horsham St. Faith and Newton St. Faith, Taverham, Attlebridge).

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A and B where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 28<sup>th</sup> December 2024 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
