Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (NTRO8919) affecting the Cromer Road from 115m south of its junction with Fifers Lane for 450m southwards (the "Road") in the Parish of Hellesdon to facilitate Anglian Water manhole cover and frame repair works, the Road shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of the existing bus lane for the duration of the works/period the suspension is necessary which is anticipated to be between 19:00 and 06:00 from 13th to 14th January 2025, but may continue until the 25th February 2025 where the suspension is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: N/A.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the suspension is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 25th February 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the suspension could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the suspension imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
